4. Lawfulness and purpose of the processing

4.1. Legal basis

- Regulation (EC) No 401/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the European Environment Agency and on the European Environment Information and Observation Network;
- The European Code of Good Administrative Behaviour adopted by decision of the EEA Management Board on 22.6.2004;
- Regulation (EC) No 1367/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 6 September 2006 on the application of the provisions of the Aarhus Convention on Access to Information, Public Participation in Decision-making and Access to Justice in Environmental Matters to Community institutions and bodies.

4.2. Grounds for lawfulness

The data processing is considered lawful because it is necessary for the performance of tasks carried out in the public interest on the basis of Regulation (EC) 401/2009 (Article 5(a) of Regulation (EC) No 45/2001) and the data subject has unambiguously given his or her consent (Article 5(d) of Regulation (EC) No 45/2001).

4.3. Purpose of the processing

The purpose of the processing is to allow all EEA staff access to contact information about EEA stakeholders and clients in order to reach a targeted audience for EEA products, information and services.

5.2. Categories of data

Data collected includes solely contact information such as organisation name, contact name, position, postal address, email address, organisation URL, telephone numbers, type of organisation, specific area of interest (environmental theme).

Data collected is retained until updated/deleted by EEA staff members at the request of the data subject concerned or due to change of address or contact details or change of position/employment.
