Clarification No 2 for Open Call for Proposals

for the award of Framework Partnership Agreements concerning European Topic Centres on Biological Diversity 2009-2013 (2 lots) (EEA/BSS/08/001) and Sustainable Consumption and Production 2009-2013 (EEA/SKI/08/001)

Questions:

Having regard to section 5.4 lit. c, point 2 on page 14 of the TOR (selection criteria, technical and professional capacity requiring: "2. A list and brief account of similar reference projects carried out by the partners forming the consortium in the past five years, with the sums, dates and recipients, public or private;"):

- 1. What are "similar reference projects" and, more particularly:
- a) How is "similarity" to be understood. Is it to be understood with regard to the tasks and activities described in this call for proposals?
- b) What are "reference projects"? Are these projects financed through grants, service contracts or any kind of financial arrangements?
- 2. As to "sums", are these total sums of the projects or total sums of the share of the project attributed to the organisation in question? In case an organisation is coordinating a consortium, is the relevant sum the total sum of the project or the share of the coordinating organisation?
- 3. As to "dates", are these to be understood as reference to the date of a project's approval, the starting date or the project's duration?
- 4. As to "recipients", are these the partners of the consortium having benefited from the financing?

Answers:

- 1. (a + b) "Similar reference projects" are projects financed in whatever form (under grants agreement; service contracts; etc.) which could be considered similar to the tasks and activities described in the TOR for this call concerning the European Topic Centre on Biological Diversity 2009-2013 (2 lots) EEA/BSS/08/001.
- 2. Regardless of the nature of involvement in a project, the "sums" to be indicated are a project's total sum as well as the share(s) of the consortium partner(s) concerned.
- 3. The "dates" to be specified are the start and end dates indicating the duration of the relevant grant agreements, service contracts, etc.
- 4. "Recipients" are the legal entities, public or private, which have awarded or initiated the relevant grant agreements, service contracts, etc.
