		meeting by the responsible meeting secretary until the minutes have been approved. Thereafter they are handed over to the Facilities services for destruction. An audit trail about the DVDs is available in a database managed by the facilities services; this audit trail provides information about the date of the recording, the meeting or event is relates to, the date it was handed over to the facilities service and the date it was destroyed.
