Teréz Krisztina Szabó is the Head of the Development Coordination and Strategic Unit in the Department of Environmental Development of the Hungarian Ministry of Agriculture. She is responsible for environmental policy planning and reporting on the implementation of the Sustainable Development Framework Strategy 2012-2024. She is coordinating the third OECD Environmental Performance Review of Hungary. Within the Ministry of Agriculture she coordinated the planning process of the Environment and Energy Operational Program for 2014-2020

Since 2011 she has been participating in the work of the European Network for Environmental and Managing Authorities (ENEA MA). Since 2015 she is member of the OECD Environmental Policy Committee and also participating in the work of the OECD Working Party on Environmental Performance. She is also responsible for coordinating the LIFE Capacity Building Project of the Ministry of Agriculture.

She has an MSc in Biology and Geography (Eötvös Loránd University, Budapest, 1995) and a master of environmental management degree from the University of Amsterdam (1998).

She started her professional career in the Strategic Department of the Ministry of Environmental Protection and Regional Development in 1995. Between 1999-2002 she was the Head of the Strategic Unit in the Energy Centre, dealing with renewable energy and energy efficiency projects. Between 2002-2005 she worked for the Delegation of the European Commission to Hungary as a project manager being responsible for the exante control and co-ordination of all environmental, energy and nuclear safety related Phare projects.

Since 2005 she has been employed in the Ministry of Environment (*now it is the Ministry of Agriculture*) in various positions.
