3. focus on delivery units for which a high completion status after gap filling with the envisaged satellite missions can be reached;

4. preference for gap filling in delivery units where the unit prices are such as to address the highest possible number of units within the available budget frame.

To cover the riparian zones-specific gaps of CORE_03 it is requested to acquire satellite data from satellites SPOT-5, SPOT-6 and Pleiades archive data for the reference year 2012 ± 2 years in order to largely fill the current within-vegetation-season data gaps in the ESA CORE_03 dataset in order to cover the prioritised riparian zones delivery units from 1 to 29.
