Clarification No 3 for open call for proposals

For the award of Framework Partnership agreements concerning four European Topic Centres on

- 1. Air Pollution and climate change mitigation 2011-2013 (EEA/ACC/10/001 ETC/ACM),
- Climate change impacts, vulnerability and adaptation 2011-2013 (EEA/NSV/10/001 ETC/CCA),
- 3. Inland, coastal and marine waters 2011-2013 (EEA/NSV/10/002 ETC/WTR), and
- 4. Spatial information and analysis 2011-2013 (EEA/NSV/10/003 ETC/SIA)

Question:

Is either of the following acceptable as co-funding?

- Effort committed to a concurrent project for another client where the actions or results of that work
 are demonstrably relevant to ETC project activities and contributes to the realization of ETC
 objectives (permission to be secured from that client for the concurrent project to act as ETC cofunding)
- Prior data or other background intellectual property which is deemed to have value, which is demonstrably relevant and which contributes to the realization of ETC objectives

Answer:

The requirement for an external co-financing specified in the Terms of reference refers to a <u>financial</u> contribution provided either by way of own resources, or in the form of financial transfers from third parties, or exceptionally in kind.

Please refer to Article 109 of the Financial Regulation (FR) applicable to the general budget of the European Communities¹ and Article 165a of the Implementing Rules (IR) of the Financial Regulation aforementioned², where it is stated that co-financing shall require that part of the costs of an action is borne by the beneficiary, or by contributions other than the Community contribution. Please refer also to Article 113 FR which provides that the grant may not finance the entire costs of the action, Article 172 (1) and (2) IR, and Article I.6.2 of the draft Framework Partnership Agreement which clearly specifies that the co-financing may be provided either from the partners' own resources or from other sources of external finance.
