Annual medical examinations

- 1. Clinical examination
- 2. X-ray of the lungs, only if the medical doctor considers it necessary (included in laboratory visit).
- 3. ECG (Electrocardiogram) every two years after the age of 40.
- 4. Laboratory tests:
 - a. Urine analysis;
 - b. Blood test:

 - Every year in case of hypertension and diabetics.
 - Every two years from the age of 40 onwards.
- 5. Gynaecological screening
 - a. Clinical examination
 - b. Cytology test (PAP smear test)
 - c. Echography of the breast and mammography from the age of 40 onwards if medically indicated
- 6. Special screening for men from the age of 45 onwards
 - a. Rectal examination of prostate
 - b. Echography of prostate from the age of 50 onwards if medically indicated
