Production tasks cover the main scope and workload of this call for tenders and consist of LC/LU change mapping 2012-2018 and status mapping 2018. Typically, LC/LU change is based on existing LC/LU status map and by merging LC/LU status 2012 and change (2012-2018) a new LC/LU status update (in this case 2018) is generated. The current N2K LC/LU product (one single file) contains three complementary elements that can be extracted:

- (a) LC/LU status layer (over a selection of N2K sites) for the reference year 2006;
- (b) LC/LU status layer (over a selection of N2K sites) for the reference year 2012;
