## II.2.4) Description of the procurement:

Pan European High Resolution Snow and Ice (S&I) activities are implemented through two separate calls for tender resulting in two separate framework service contracts. The first S&I contract, resulting from call for tenders EEA/DIS/R0/18/014, implements products based on Sentinel 2 A/B and entered into force earlier this year. The future contractor is expected to extend Europe's High resolution S&I monitoring capabilities with products derived from active sensors on Sentinel 1, currently in orbit A and B.

In detail the following extensions are expected:

- Task 1: Differentiation of wet/dry snow within snow mask;
- Task 2: Gap filling of Fractional Snow Cover;
- Task 3: River and Lake Ice;
- Task 4: Harmonisation with Copernicus Land Monitoring Service global component;
