## Clarification No 3

## Reference: Open call for tenders No EEA/OSE/14/001

Title: $\quad$ Framework service contract for the provision of printing, layout and design services

## Question 1

In preparation of our tender we would like to get a clarification to article 9.3 .2 concerning number of pages. For print technical reasons would we like to use page numbers that are divisible by 8 and calculate our prices based on the following number of pages:

P1: 304 pages +4 pages cover
P2: 48 pages +4 pages cover
P3: 48 pages +4 pages cover
P4: 16 pages +4 pages cover

We are slightly worried about that our bid will not be regarded as admissible if we base our prices on a wrong basis so we would like to get your comments to the above.

## Answer 1

The offer shall be based on that the total number of pages is divisible by four, but not necessarily eight. Therefore P1 should be based on 300 pages and $P 4$ on 16 pages. For P2 and P3 one should add two pages, so these prices should be based on 52 pages.

Please note that Annex I - Technical Specifications related to this procedure shall be amended accordingly. A Consolidated version is enclosed to the tender documentation.
