The purpose of the proposed contract is to purchase training sessions as follows:

### Lot 1:

General ergo therapy training - approximately 2 hours once a year (at the EEA – all staff); Individual ergo therapy sessions at work stations – approximately 20 minutes per staff member (at the EEA – as required).

### Lot 2:

Fitness/Gymnastic sessions – 3 days a week – approximately 60 minutes each (at the EEA – approximately 15 persons per session);

It is expected that tenderers are submitting an offer for both lots.
