

## Pekka Harju-Autti

Pekka Harju-Autti is Ministrial Advisor in the Finnish Ministry of the Environment, in the Department of Natural Environment. Currently he acts as LIFE-Committee Member and Finnish National Contact Point (NCP) for both LIFE Environment and Resource Efficiency and Life Nature and Biodiversity projects. He coordinates Finnish national R&D activities in the Department of Natural Environment. He is a member of the Advisory Board of Finnish NGOs and the Governmental Democracy Network.

He has a PhD in technology, with a specification in 1) global indicator of environmental awareness in countries; 2) environmental worldviews in political parties, organizations and individuals. He has also Masters Degree in Civil Engineering (Municipal and Environmental Engineering).

Before the career in the Finnish Ministry of the Environment, Pekka has been a scientific researcher at SCK/CEN (studiecenter voor kernenergie), in Mol, Belgium and at Finnish Environment Institute (SYKE). At SCK/CEN his research area focused to environmental impacts of radioactive waste disposal. In SYKE his research area comprised environmental awareness in the Baltic Sea Area.

In 2013 Pekka was appointed as Alternate Finnish Member to the Management Board of the European Environment Agency (EEA).
