Aude Charrier is **head of the European action department in the French Ministry for ecological transition**. She is responsible for coordinating the positions of all services under the ministry in EU negotiations, preparing EU Council of environment, energy and transport ministers and following bilateral relationships with all European countries.

She followed her carreer in this ministry, first at regional level, by being in charge of flood and water management policies for the Seine river basin. After a brief experience in the European Commission, dealing with projects funding for climate change adaptation in developing countries, she then became environment counsellor at the Permanent representation of France to the European Union in Brussels. Back in Paris, she was deputy head of the climate change department, in the directorate general for energy and climate in the same ministry, in charge of climate mitigation national policies.

Ms. Charrier is a graduate of the Ecole Polytechnique and the Ecole des Ponts et Chaussées, both in Paris.
