**Dr Costas A. Constantinou**

**Dr Costas A. Constantinou** holds a degree in **Geology** (University of Athens), a diploma in **Water Resources Development & Management** (Hebrew University of Jerusalem), and a **PhD in Hydrogeology–Geology** (University of Patras).

From **1993 to 2020**, he served in the **Cyprus Geological Survey Department**, ultimately becoming **Director**. During this period, he coordinated numerous research programmes with European and international institutions, focusing on groundwater and mineral resources, geo-hazards, and the geological environment. He also represented Cyprus in several national and international committees, including **EuroGeoSurveys**, the **International Union of Geological Sciences (IUGS)**, UNESCO's Tsunami Group, and various governmental advisory bodies.

In **2020**, he was appointed **Permanent Secretary**, serving in the following capacities:

- **Permanent Secretary, Cyprus Ministry of Interior (9/2020–6/2023)** – overseeing urban planning, real estate, local governance, housing, migration policy, the civil registry, civil protection, and electoral processes.
- **Permanent Secretary, Cyprus Deputy Ministry of Tourism (7/2023–11/2025)** – responsible for tourism strategy, seasonal expansion, product quality, and sectoral development.
- **Permanent Secretary, Cyprus Directorate-General for the Environment (12/2025–present)** – leading national policy on environment, forestry, fisheries, geology, geohazards, mineral resources, waste management, biodiversity, climate adaptation, and the aggregates industry.
