User data is also used by EEA and its delegated representatives to contact data subjects with queries or feedback concerning information or data submitted to the BDR.
1.7	Description of categories of persons whose data the EEA processes and list of data categories	Persons whose data is processed are company reporters using BDR to submit company-related data. The only personal data collected and further processed is the information encoded by the designated company reporter him/herself in the on-line form, which include in particular: oName (title, first name and surname) and function;

1.8	Time limit for keeping the data	Personal data is kept for communication purposes as long as follow- up actions to the yearly reporting obligations are necessary. Thereafter, personal data is kept for historical purpose only and to maintain change logs.
1.9	Recipients of the data	The BDR is not publicly accessible. All recipients of the data are on a "need to know" basis, and are: Designated EEA project managers and helpdesk managers; Designated external experts or contractors who work on behalf of the EEA for the purpose of data management and compilation, quality assessment and evaluation; The competent European Commission staff members as well as contractors who work on behalf of the European Commission; For ODS and F-gas reporters only: designated Member State staff members (access is restricted to the data relevant for the specific Member State).

1.11	General description of security measures (where possible)	The personal data collected in the Reportnet Business Data Repository (BDR) can only be accessed by designated EEA staff members and designated external experts or contractors acting on its behalf using a valid Username and Password. The designated EEA staff members as well as the designated external experts or contractors who work on behalf of the EEA sign a declaration of confidentiality every year before performing any work pertaining to the management and administration of the BDR.
