NARRATIVE:





Basic Level Cognition

Basic-Level Cognition: Embodied knowledge

Communication using basic level cognition is most effective:

- Activates the largest number of brain circuits (motoric simulation, emotions, smells)
- Activates mental pictures
- Processes the fastest
- Is remembered easiest
