Where did it come from?

Non-sourced 42.5%

Hard to know where it's from - mainly because it's too tiny to identify.

Fishing 9.6%

All the things that help anglers and commercial fishermen catch fish from lines to lures.

SRD 7%

Sewage Related Debris is stuff that's flushed down the loo but should go in the bin.

Medical 0.2%

Not very nice - pill packets to syringes.

Fly Tipped 0.8%

Big stuff like TVs and tyres.

Shipping 3.2%


Stuff lost overboard, or thrown from small craft or massive ships.




